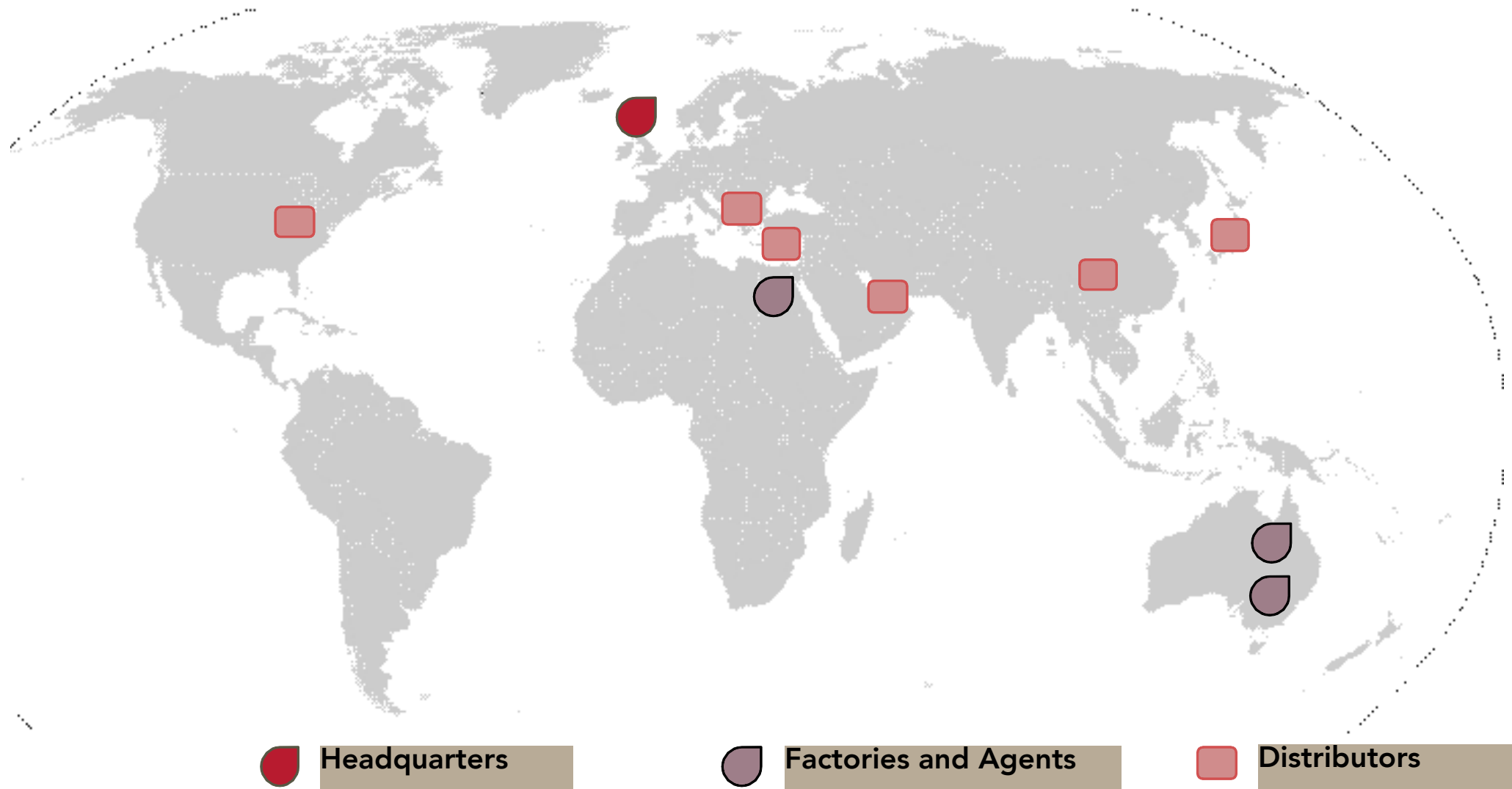

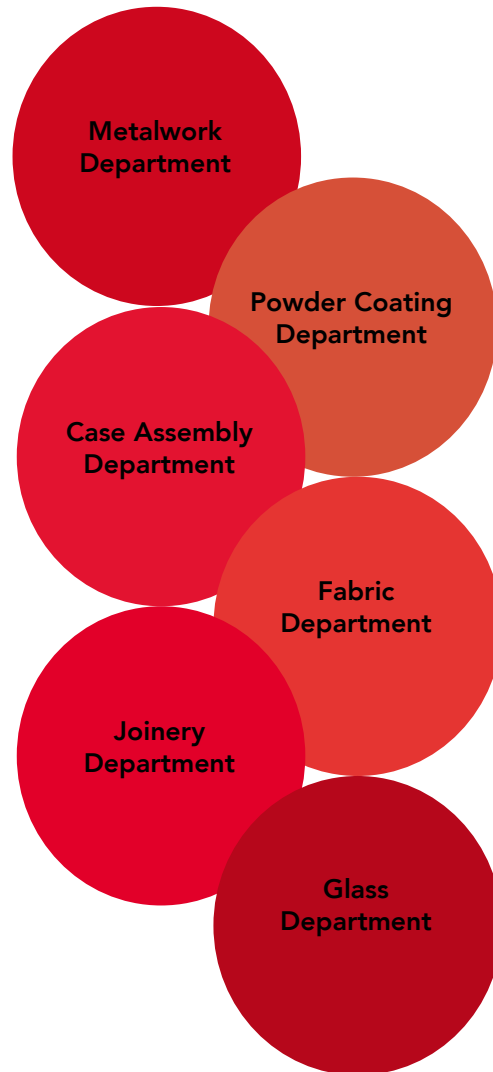
Our headquarters are in Livingston, Scotland (just to the west of the historic city of Edinburgh). We have a large factory where we carry out the manufacturing for our showcases.

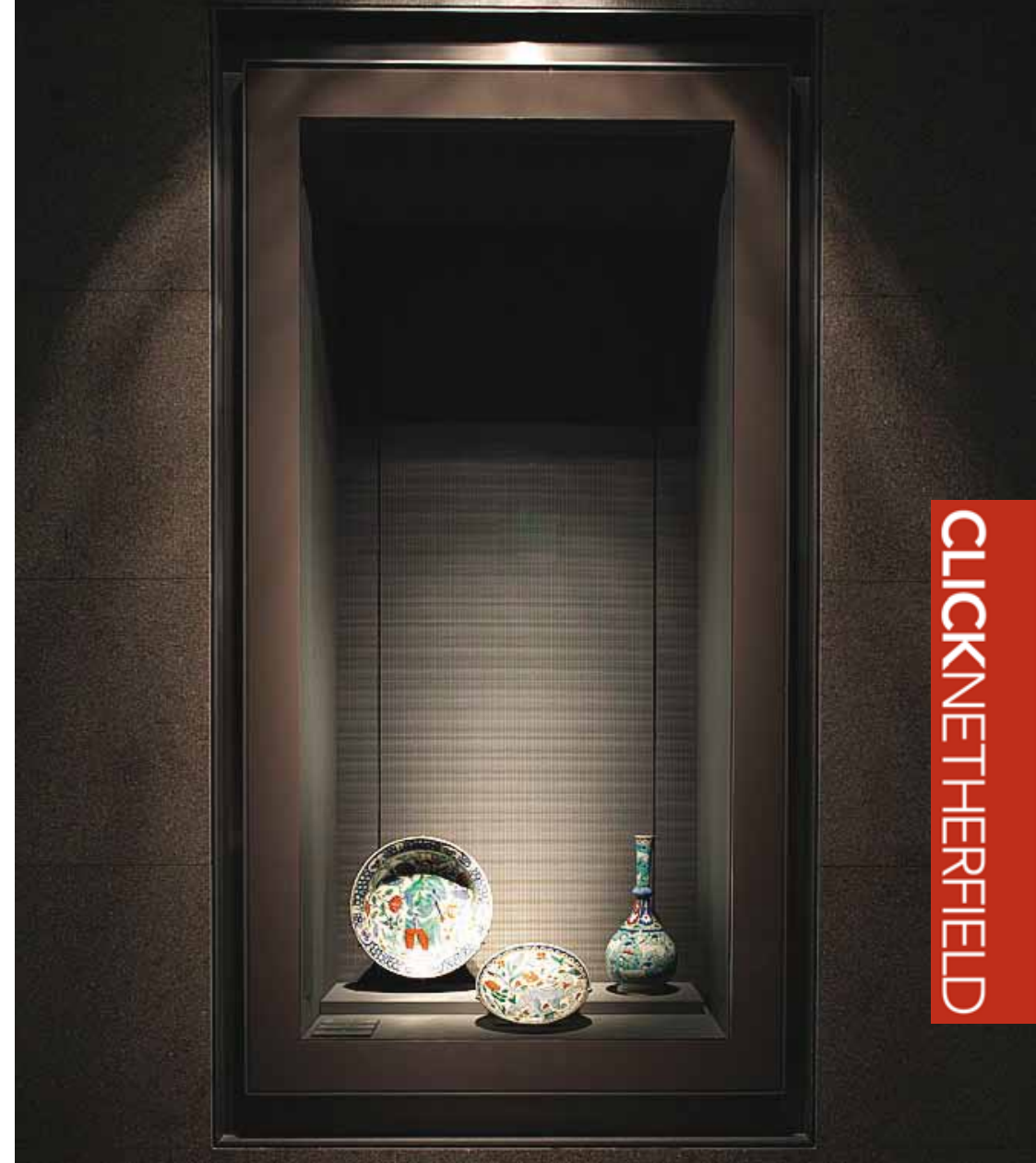
