today people focus more than ever on aspects that make their homes healthier and more comfortable and secure. In this context windows can offer many benefits, such as optimum day light, improved sound insulation and healthy, natural ventilation.

From our research in the ift-project "insulated glazing units with reduced weight" we are presenting recommendations for practical applications, surprising results on the suitability of use of structural glazing facades after 25 years of practical testing, and information on generating energy in facades using photobioreactors.

As always you can expect information on the changes in standards and regulations, e.g. the stricter requirements on **solar screening**, the new termsinology and documentary evidence required in **sound insulation**, the requirements for **timber preservation**, for **determining the size of glass** and for implementing accessible building components. A first report on practical cases by companies, out of law courts and market monitoring after the introduction of the **Construction Products Regulation** (BauPV) will highlight the importance of these topics.

We will give you **tips on the cost efficiency** of energy upgrade and modernisation measures, and provide an insight into workings of the "giant refurbishment machine" of the **housing industry**. In addition, there will be practical information on installation issues, on designing ventilation systems and on reliably preventing the formation of condensate.
